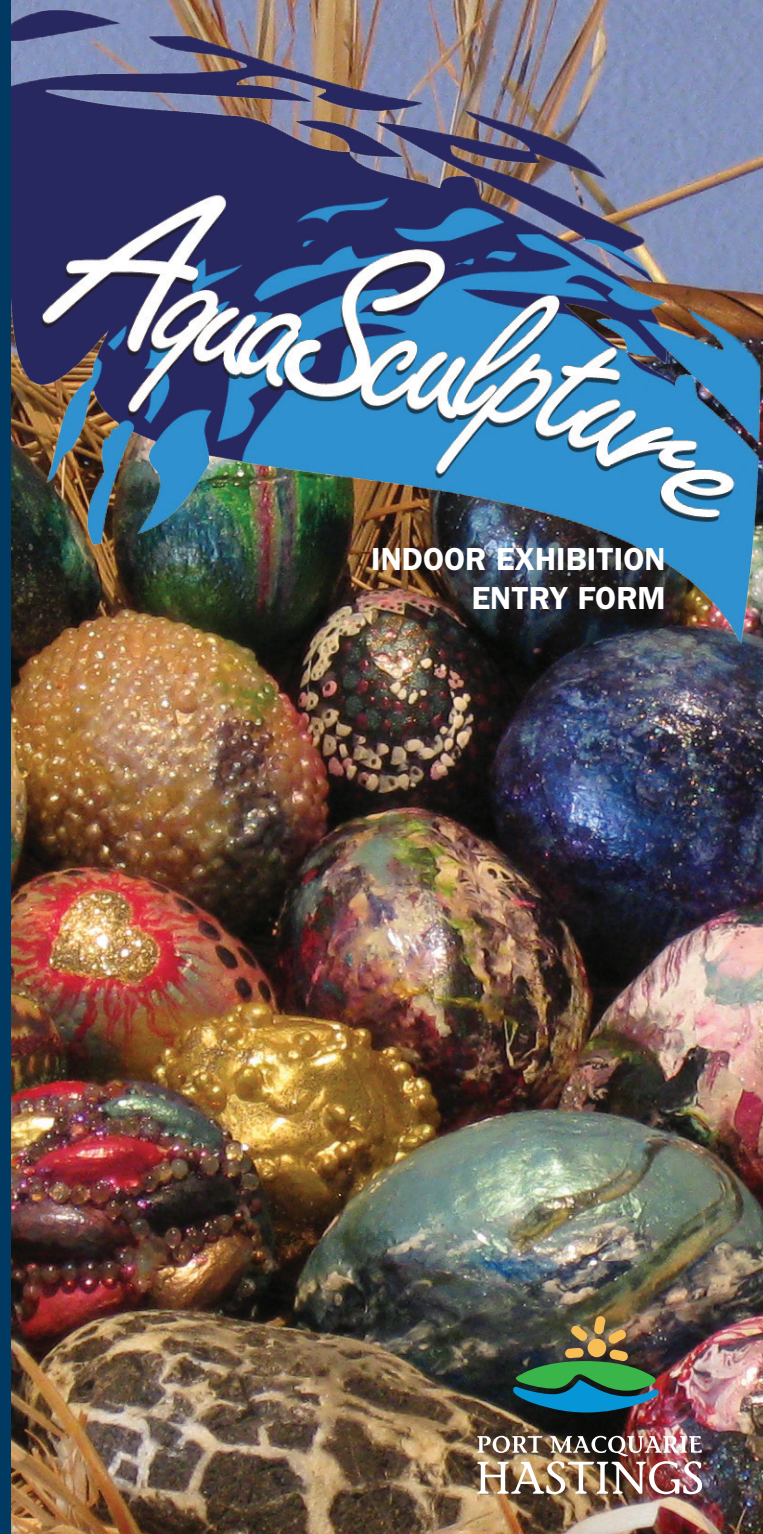

5. Artists are responsible for insuring their works against loss, theft or damage.

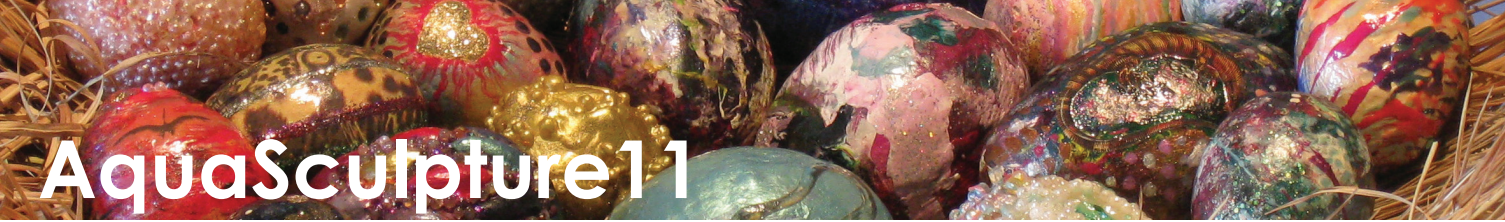

EXCITING NEWS ABOUT OUR COMPETITION, EXHIBITIONS AND COMMUNITY WORKSHOPS

Biennially from 2003, AquaSculpture has given locals and visitors the opportunity to enjoy sculptures, meet their creators and participate in their making. We have great plans for 2011 - here is a snapshot.

6 October - 4 December: Confluence exhibition at the Glasshouse Regional Gallery – anyone can drop in any day of the week except Mondays when the Gallery is closed.

This year's Confluence features sculptors.

7 - 14 October: Community sculpture workshops with a key artist confirmed - much acclaimed Indigenous sculptor Lorraine Connelly-Northey (invited exhibitor at the 2010 Sydney Biennale, Museum of Contemporary Art) – with well-known local artists Stephen Killick and Jo Davidson.

Workshops will be held at the Scouts Hall, Hollingworth St, Port Macquarie.

This is an opportunity for artists and families to participate in a sculpture event, at a very reasonable cost (adults \$5 per day, children \$2, includes a light lunch).

14 – 15 October: Entries in the outdoor sculpture exhibition will be assembled on the Town Green.

14 – 23 October: AquaSculpture11 Headquarters will be on Town Green in The Beach House building.

15 October: Judging of outdoor sculptures. Exhibitors' party.

16 October @ 11.00am: Official opening and announcement of prize winners on the Town Green.

18 – 23 October: Exhibition of small sculptures in the Glasshouse mezzanine foyer.

23 October @ 11.00am: Announcement of the Peoples' Choice award, followed by de-installation/recovery of works.
